# Eligibility to Club Membership

  - Economics, political science, finance, investment studies, business administration, sociology, history, philosophy and law.

# Political Structure of the Club

- ⌚ An economist or a senior member of the economics or finance department must always be the patron of the club in each institution;
- ⌚ The club will have the following:
  - ⌚ One president and two vice-presidents. At least one of the three officials must be female;
  - ⌚ A club secretary, financial secretary, treasurer and public relations officer
  - ⌚ All positions must be democratically filled and approved by the patron.



# Funding & Support

- ☞ ValueFronteira – the initiating organization - will provide minimal financial support where necessary however,
- ☞ Every particular branch of the Fronteira Club nationwide will have responsibility for its own financial management;
  - ☞ The branch shall determine how much they intend to contribute for their own development only;
  - ☞ No funds need be remitted to the national headquarters or to ValueFronteira as such funds are not needed;
  - ☞ All club's spending must be approved by the patron of the particular club;
  - ☞ Financial position of the club must be made available to all members as regularly as should be determined by the particular club.

# National Fronteira Summits

- There shall be an annual National Fronteira summit at the Federal capital Territory where all members who can afford it will convene to review macroeconomic performance and make recommendations to government;
- New executives of the Fronteira Club at the national level will be elected;
- ValueFronteira will financially support the operations of the club at the headquarters.

# Compliance Issues

-  No Fronteira Club can be allowed to exist in any Nigerian higher institution without a patron duly appointed by the head of economics or finance of the school;
-  Club activities must be further supervised by the patron to ensure that they are consistent with the goals of the Club and do not breach either the laws of the school or the country
